

OFFICIAL EXCURSION - Šumava National Park

June 25, 2022

Option A

Hiking and crayfish

8:30

Departure from bus parking ([maps here](#))

You will receive a lunch package.

9:30 – 10:15

Kramata reservoir

- Reservoir with an abundant population of noble crayfish which was supposed as the possible ark site in the past.
- Crayfish capture by traps and hand capture with a baited stick.

10:30 – 11:30

Borová Lada hatchery

- Fish hatchery of the National Park Šumava.
- Based in Borová Lada, the primary activities of the fish hatchery are maintaining and breeding fish species that are native to and desirable for Šumava ecosystems.
- Example of the successful repatriation of the native noble crayfish population.

11:40 – 12:30

Chalupská slat'

- Chalupská slat' - a short nature trail taking you to the largest peaty lake of Šumava.
- The trail initially has an uneven asphalt surface, which after 200 metres leads into a slight incline and opens into a boarded walkway. Please note that the walkway is 120 cm wide and runs approximately 30 cm above the surface of the moor.
- The reward for arriving at the end of the trail is a beautiful view of the lake and the surrounding moor.
- Total length of 1.2 km of easy hiking trail.

12:45 – 13:30

Kvilda

- Short break.
- Traditional bakery and small brewery.

13:50 – 15:30

Srní – wolf trail 2 km ([details here](#))

- Nice trail through forest finishing with wolves enclosure with 9 wolves.
- Through the wolf enclosure, the path goes on a 300-meter-long wooden bridge installed 3-4 meters over the terrain with viewing shelters. On the bridge signs provide information about the wolf-pack communication.
- Visitors center - Presentation about wild animals. Online cameras in the enclosure transmitting real-time images to the visitor center.
