

OFFICIAL EXCURSION - Šumava National Park - July 4

Option A

Borová Lada

- The Šumava National Park fish hatchery.
- Based in Borová Lada, the primary activities of the fish hatchery entails maintaining and breeding fish species that are native to, and desirable, for Šumavian ecosystems.
- Example of the successful restoration repatriation of the native noble crayfish population.

Chalupská slat'

- Chalupská slat' - a 1.2 km easy nature trail to the largest peat lake in Czech Republic.
- The trail initiates with a 200 m uneven asphalt surface, which ascends to a boarded walkway. The walkway is 120 cm wide and runs approximately 30 cm above the surface of the moor.
- Hikers are rewarded with a beautiful view of the lake and the surrounding moor at the end of the trail.

Srní – Wolf trail 2 km (http://www.npsumava.cz/gallery/39/11770-nc_srni_aj.pdf)

- Nice trail through forest finishing at a wolf enclosure with nine wolves.
- Through the wolf enclosure, the path goes on a 300-meter-long wooden sky trail installed 3-4 meters over the terrain with viewing shelters. Signs on the bridge provide information about the wolf-pack.
- Visitors center – presentation about wild animals. Online cameras in the enclosure transmitting real-time images to the visitor center.
