

OFFICIAL EXCURSION - Šumava National Park - July 4

Option B

Srní – Wolf trail 2 km (http://www.npsumava.cz/gallery/39/11770-nc_srni_aj.pdf)

- Nice trail through forest finishing at a wolf enclosure with nine wolves.
- Through the wolf enclosure, the path goes on a 300-meter-long wooden sky trail installed 3-4 meters over the terrain with viewing shelters. Signs on the bridge provide information about the wolf-pack.
- Visitors center – presentation about wild animals. Online cameras in the enclosure transmitting real-time images to the visitor center.

Kvilda – Short break, visit to traditional bakery. <http://www.pekarnakvilda.cz/pekarna>

Kramata

- An example of the native noble crayfish locality in the Šumava National park.
- Considered a possible Ark site for noble crayfish in the past.

Vimperk – Křesánovský brook

- Small brook situated less than 3 km from Kramata pond.
- Inhabited by signal crayfish for at least 15 years.
- At the upper stretch, the rest of noble crayfish population.
- Possible refreshment in the restaurant in close proximity to the brook.
